Next year he will most likely attend the local junior high school for a couple of periods and homeschool with me for the rest, as his older brother is doing now.

my other son, is now 14 years old, and has attended 2 periods a day at the local junior high school and is a straight A student. He still prefers and misses, as do I, homeschooling the way we used to do it before I began fulltime employment. That first year was an adjustment for us all, but we are coping well under the circumstances and moving on.
